**1. INTRODUCTION:-**

Industrial Training Institute, Solan is one of ITI's located in the State of Himachal Pradesh. This Institute was established on **19<sup>th</sup> February 1959** with six trades viz Draughtsman (Civil), Surveyor, Fitter, Electrician, Welder and Carpenter having an intake capacity of 92 seats only. But now after successfully functioning for 50 years, it has risen to the status of well-reputed Model Industrial Training Institute of the State with 23 trades consisting of 33 units having a sanctioned strength of 620 seats in various Engineering & Non-Engineering Trades.

**2. LOCATION:-**

ITI Solan is located in the heart of the city below the Mall Road and is near to Railway Station and new Bus Stand. It is about 45 Km from the capital city of the state Shimla and 75 Km from the Chandigarh.

**3. LAND & BUILDING:-**

- This Institute has adequate land and building with a **total area of 8960 Sq.m.** This Institute was started in the **old building** in the year **1959**.
- The **hostel building** having an intake **capacity of 100 trainees** was taken over on **1st August 1968**.
- The **New Workshop Building** was taken over on **4<sup>th</sup> June 1971**. Now, the ITI has the accommodation for staff also.
- At present, there are **6 Nos. of Type-II quarters** for staff and **1 No. Type-IV quarter** for **Principal**.
- **Type-II quarters** were taken over in **August 1992** and **Type-IV quarter** was taken over in **August 1994**.

- **Additional Workshop Building and Administration Block** was taken over on **11<sup>th</sup> December 1998**.
- The additional workshop building for Centre of Excellence in Electronics Sector was taken over on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2008.

#### 4. **"ISO-9001-2000" Certification for ITI, Solan :-**

Govt. I.T.I. Solan has been certified as "ISO-9001: 2000" by Moody International Ltd. On 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2005 Thus I.T.I. Solan has become first Govt. I.T.I. in Himachal Pradesh as well as in the Northern Region to achieve ISO-9001:2000 certification. I.T.I. Solan has also become the first Educational Institute in Solan city to get ISO-9001-2000 certification.

#### 5. **"Center of Excellence" in Electronics Sector for ITI Solan:-**

ITI Solan has been selected among 100 ITI's in the country by DGE&T(Directorate General of Employment & Training), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India for **Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme of Up gradation of ITI's into "Centers of Excellence" in "Electronics Sector**

- These centers will be providing "**Multiskill Training**" to meet the skill requirement of particular sector of industry with the active involvement of the industry in all aspects of training.
- The **training** will be provided in **three parts** as under:
  - (i) **Training in Basic Skill Areas** for a period of **one year**
  - (ii) **Training in Advanced Modules** for next **six months**  
The **testing and certification** for the basic skill training during first year and also for advanced training during next six months will be conducted by **NCVT** (National Council for Vocational Training)
  - (iii) **Training in Specialized Modules** mainly **in the industry** (The course Curricula, duration etc. will be designed in consultations with the IMC (Institute Managing Committee)/Local Industry. The trade testing & certification for this component will be done jointly by the State Government & Industry. Said certificate will be recognized by NCVT
- The training Programme will have **multi-entry** and **multi-exit** provisions:
  - (i) Trainees can opt to go to Labour Market after completing Broad Based Training of one year as well as after completing 1½ years of training
  - (ii) Trainees can come back after some time to seek admission for advanced/specialized training in another module.
  - (iii) ITI pass out trainees of the particular trade(s) from the conventional system can seek admission for advanced/specialized training

## **7. Details of 92 MES (Modular Employable Skill) Courses under SDI (Skill Development Initiative ) Scheme of Govt. of India available in ITI Solan:-**

ITI Solan has become first ITI in Himachal Pradesh to start 92 courses in 10 sectors in the various Flexible Delivery Mechanism (Part Time, weekends, full time, onsite/ offsite to suit needs of various target groups) MES (Modular Employable Skill) courses under SDI (Skill Development Initiative) scheme of DGE&T (Directorate General of Employment & Training), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India under N.C.V.T.

These courses has been started in ITI Solan w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> March 2008.

### **Main Features of SDI Scheme:-**

#### **Target Group**

MES courses would benefit different target groups like workers seeking certification of their skills acquired informally, workers and ITI graduates seeking skill up gradation, early school drop-outs & unemployed.

#### **Training Fee**

Following training fee which includes cost of material, honorarium, etc. has been prescribed by DGE&T. **The training fee of all the successful candidates will be refunded to them by Govt. of India :**

- i. Rs.500 per module for modules having duration up to 90 hrs.
- ii. Rs.1000 per module for modules having duration from 91 to 180 hrs.

- iii. Rs.1500 per module for modules having duration from 181 hrs to 270 hrs.
  - iv. Rs.2000 per module for modules having duration more than 270 hrs.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST category and women will be given relaxation of 25% in fee.

### **Testing and Certification**

DGE&T (Directorate General Employment & Training), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India will appoint assessing bodies to assess the competencies of the trained persons. The assessing body will be an independent agency, which will not be involved in conducting the training programmes.

The essence of the scheme is in the certification that will be nationally and internationally recognized. Successful persons will be awarded certificates issued by National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT).

#### **Assessment/Testing Fee**

The assessment fee will be Rs.300-800 depending on the skill area to be assessed. The assessment fee will be reimbursed to all the successful persons who have received training from approved VTPs (Vocational Training Providers)

Keeping in view the rapid changes in the technology brought by the liberalization, a scheme was drawn to modernize the old machinery for equipping the trainees with the latest technology and skill to compete with the imported products. **The World Bank Assistance Scheme to modernize the machinery and equipment was introduced in ITI, Solan in 1986-87. 90% machinery and equipment has been replaced under World Bank Scheme since, 1986 incurring an expenditure amounting to Rs. 90, 11,325/- (90 lacs approx.)**

Government Establishments falling under the jurisdiction of this Institute. The related instructions to the trade apprentices are imparted in this Institute.

## **17. TRAINING FOR THE YOUTH OF SC/ST FOR SELF EMPLOYMENT**

This Institute is also imparting training to the candidates selected and sponsored by SC/ST Corporation under various schemes in Motor Mechanic, Electrician & Hair & Skin Care trades. So far, 250 youths have been trained under this scheme.

## **18. INDUSTRY-INSTITUTE INTERACTION PROGRAMME :-**

- For the industrial growth in Himachal Pradesh and for Industry to meet the challenges of new technology, there is need for close cooperation and harmonious relations between Institute and Industry.
- The need of the Industry-Institute Interaction Programme is to raise the skills of the students to match the requirements of the industry and to fill the gap between the trainees of ITI and the need of the modern industry.
- With a view to achieve above objectives, the trainees of various trades make industrial visits.
- In April, 1998, Confederation of Indian Industries (CII) has selected 5 ITI's as Pilot Project for Industry-Institute Interaction in the country from the states of Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, J&K, Delhi and Chandigarh .ITI, Solan of Himachal Pradesh is one of the amongst them.
